BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities, aggregated \$12,033,000,000 or 1.4 per cent above the total of \$11,869,000,000 reported for the preceding week. The largest increases are as follows: Boston \$79,000,000, Chicago \$30,000,000, Philadelphia \$24,000,000, and Detroit \$23,000,000. The principal decline, \$16,000,000, was reported for banks in Cleveland.

As compared with the week ending January 23, 1924, debits for the week/show an increase of \$2,278,000,000 or 23.4 per cent, most of the leading centers reporting increases. New York City shows an increase of \$1,401,000,000. Other increases are as follows: Chicago \$153,000,000, Boston - \$145,000,000, Philadelphia \$80,000,000, San Francisco - \$36,000,000, Minneapolis - \$34,000,000 and St. Louis \$29,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, aggregated \$11,368,617,000 as compared with \$11,219,491,000 for the preceding week and \$9,193,755,000 for the week ending January 23, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 253 centers, of which 247 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
