BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending March 11, aggregated \$11,020,000,000 or 10.6 per cent below the total of \$12,328,000,000 reported for the preceding week. All of the more important centers except Detroit and Washington report reductions for the week. The principal decreases are as follows: New York City \$502,000,000, San Francisco \$123,000,000, Philadelphia \$96,000,000, Boston \$68,000,000, Chicago \$67,000,000, and Los Angeles \$61,000,000. Increases of \$29,000,000 and \$14,000,000, respectively, are reported for Detroit and Washington.

As compared with the week ending March 12, 1924, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$1,980,000,000 or 21.9 per cent, most of the larger centers participating in the increase. New York City reports an increase of \$1,439,000,000, while other large increases are as follows: Chicago \$88,000,000, Boston \$55,000,000, Philadelphia \$49,000,000, Detroit \$31,000,000 and San Francisco and Minneapolis \$29,000,000 and \$26,000,000, respectively.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$10,401,723,000 as compared with \$11,653,540,000 for the preceding week and \$8,488,224,000 for the week ending March 12, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 254 centers, of which 250 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
