BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending March 25, aggregated \$11,148,000,000 or 10.2 per cent below the total of \$12,420,000,000 reported for the preceding week. All of the more important centers report reductions for the week. The principal decreases are as follows: New York City \$612,000,000, Chicago \$116,000,000, Philadelphia \$38,000,000, St. Louis \$34,000,000, Minneapolis \$32,000,000, Cleveland \$29,000,000, and Boston and Baltimore \$24,000,000, each.

As compared with the week ending March 26, 1924, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$1,302,000,000 or 13.2 per cent. New York City reports an increase of \$285,000,000, while other large increases are as follows: Chicago \$90,000,000, Philadelphia \$43,000,000, San Francisco \$39,000,000, Boston and Pittsburgh \$21,000,000 each, and Dallas \$19,000,000. The largest decrease, \$14,000,000, was reported by Denver.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$10,545,871,000 as compared with \$11,741,443,000 for the preceding week and \$9,296,114,000 for the week ending March 26, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 256 centers, of which 251 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
