BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending April 22, aggregated \$11,463,000,000 or 10.7 per cent above the total of \$10,352,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reported an increase of \$1,095,000,000, Philadelphia of \$53,000,000, Chicago of \$42,000,000, and Detroit of \$32,000,000. Of the more important centers, the following reported decreases: Cleveland \$66,000,000, St. Louis \$16,000,000, Cincinnati \$13,000,000, and Seattle \$12,000,000.

As compared with the week ending April 23, 1924, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$2,368,000,000, or 26 per cent. Increases were reported for all of the more important centers except Omaha, Denver and Portland. An increase of \$1,731,000,000 was reported by New York City, while other large increases were as follows: Chicago \$101,000,000, Boston \$86,000,000, St. Louis \$27,000,000, Detroit \$24,000,000, San Francisco \$23,000,000, and Minneapolis \$20,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were about \$10,800,000,000, as compared with \$9,690,630,000 for the preceding week and \$8,517,642,000 for the week ending April 23, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 254 centers, of which 251 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
