BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending June 17, aggregated \$12,318,000,000 or 14.9 per cent above the total of \$10,720,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reported an increase of \$867,000,000, while other large increases were as follows: Chicago \$173,000,000, Philadelphia \$123,000,000, Detroit \$72,000,000, Cleveland \$55,000,000, San Francisco \$36,000,000, Pittsburgh \$22,000,000 and Baltimore \$21,000,000.

As compared with the week ending June 18, 1924, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$1,473,000,000 or 13.6 per cent. Substantially larger debits are shown for all of the more important centers, the principal increases being as follows: New York City \$710,000,000, Chicago \$141,000,000, Detroit \$60,000,000, Philadelphia \$58,000,000, Cleveland \$41,000,000, San Francisco \$28,000,000 and Minneapolis \$22,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$11,609,530,000, as compared with \$10,054,702,000 for the preceding week and \$10,215,910,000 for the week ending June 18, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 257 centers, of which 255 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
