BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending June 24, aggregated \$11,071,000,000 or 10.1 per cent below the total of \$12,318,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reported a decline of \$745,000,000, while other large reductions were as follows: Chicago \$105,000,000, Cleveland \$53,000,000, St. Louis \$58,000,000, San Francisco \$25,000,000 and Philadelphia \$22,000,000. The largest increase, \$64,000,000, was reported for Boston.

As compared with the week ending June 25, 1924, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$1,565,000,000 or 16.5 per cent. Substantially larger debits are shown for all of the more important centers, the principal increases being as follows: New York City \$854,000,000, Boston \$89,000,000, Philadelphia \$63,000,000, Chicago \$56,000,000, Detroit \$46,000,000, Pittsburgh \$40,000,000 and San Francisco \$33,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers, for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$10,411,767,000, as compared with \$11,609,530,000 for the preceding week and \$8,928,177,000 for the week ending June 25, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 257 centers, of which 255 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
