BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending September 9, aggregated \$8,687,000,000 - 18.4 per cent below the total of \$10,641,000,000 reported for the preceding week. The current week included September 7, observed as a holiday throughout the country, and therefore, contained but five business days. New York City reported a decline of \$1,202,000,000, Chicago a decline of \$119,000,000, San Francisco of \$77,000,000, Philadelphia of \$66,000,000, and Los Angeles of \$51,000,000.

As compared with the week ending September 10, 1924, which contained six business days, debits for the week under review declined by \$628,000,000 or by 6.9 per cent. The principal decreases reported were New York City - \$423,000,000, Chicago - \$34,000,000, Boston - \$32,000,000, and Los Angeles - \$21,000,000, while Detroit reported an increase of \$32,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$8,123,973,000, as compared with \$10,018,561,000 for the preceding week and \$8,707,766,000 for the week ending September 10, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 255 centers, of which 253 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
