## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending October 14, aggregated \$10,663,000,000, or 21 per cent below the total of \$13,461,000,000 reported for the preceding week. The large reduction is due in part to the fact that October 12, Columbus Day, was observed as a holiday in many of the States, and partly to the fact that the previous week included the usual heavy end-of-month payments. New York City reported a decline of \$1,794,000,000, Boston \$180,000,000, Chicago \$175,000,000, Philadelphia \$92,000,000, Pittsburgh \$73,000,000, Cleveland \$35,000,000 and San Francisco \$33,000,000. The largest increase, \$24,000,000, was reported by Detroit.

As compared with the week ending October 15, 1924, debits for the week under review were larger by \$1,218,000,000, or 13 per cent. Substantial increases are shown for most of the more important centers, the principal increases being as follows: New York City \$774,000,000, Chicago \$92,000,000, Boston \$47,000,000, Detroit \$45,000,000 and Philadelphia \$44,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, amounted to \$10,001,553,000, as compared with \$12,682,454,000 for the preceding week and \$8,837,171,000 for the week ending October 15, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 255 centers, of which 253 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
