BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts as reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in leading cities for the week ending January 27, aggregated \$12,386,000,000 or 9.2 per cent below the total of \$13,640,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reported a decline of \$705,000,000, while other large reductions were as follows: Boston \$119,000,000, St. Louis and San Francisco \$26,000,000 each, Kansas City \$24,000,000, Philadelphia \$23,000,000, and Cincinnati \$22,000,000.

As compared with the week ending January 28, 1925, debits for the week under review are larger by \$1,478,000,000 or 13.5 per cent. Increases were reported for most of the more important centers, the largest increases being as follows: New York City \$848,000,000, Chicago \$152,000,000, Detroit \$53,000,000, Philadelphia \$51,000,000, Cleveland and San Francisco \$30,000,000 each, Los Angeles \$22,000,000, and Pittsburgh \$19,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, amounted to \$11,892,851,000 as compared with \$12,840,313,000 for the preceding week and \$10,285,760,000 for the week ending January 28, 1925.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 258 centers, all of which are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
