BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in leading cities for the week ending May 12, aggregated \$11,486,000,000 or 16.9 per cent below the total of \$13,822,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Debits for the week under review are \$540,000,000 or 5.9 per cent above those for the week ending May 13, 1925, increases being reported for most of the larger centers. The principal increases were as follows: New York City \$248,000,000, Chicago \$69,000,000, Boston \$50,000,000, San Francisco \$23,000,000 and Detroit \$20,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, amounted to \$10,780,480,000, as compared with \$13,057,230,000 for the preceding week and \$10,278,648,000 for the week ending May 13, 1925.
