BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending August 4, aggregated \$12,952,000,000 or 18.3 per cent above the total of \$10,946,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Debits for the week under review are \$1,517,000,000 or 13.3 per cent above those for the week ending August 5, 1925. New York City reported an increase of \$1,179,000,000, while other large increases were as follows: Chicago \$46,000,000, Boston and Cleveland \$36,000,000 each, San Francisco \$26,000,000, Los Angeles \$22,000,000 and Philadelphia \$20,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919, amounted to about \$12,234,000,000, as compared with \$10,282,104,000 for the preceding week and \$10,759,557,000 for the week ending August 5, 1925.
