BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending September 29, aggregated \$11,434,000,000 or 9.9 per cent below the total of \$12,690,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Total debits for the week under review are \$611,000,000 or 5.1 per cent below those for the week ending September 30, 1925. New York City reports a decline of \$238,000,000 as compared with last year, Chicago \$147,000,000, Philadelphia \$68,000,000 and Minneapolis \$25,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$10,759,865,000 as compared with \$11,944,330,000 for the preceding week and \$11,346,627,000 for the week ending September 30, 1925.
