BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending March 30, 1927, aggregated \$13,228,000,000 or 3.9 per cent below the total of \$13,759,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Total debits for the week under review are \$224,000,000 or 1.7 per cent below those for the week ending March 31, 1926. Chicago reported a reduction of \$111,000,000, New York \$78,000,000, St. Louis \$21,000,000 and Detroit \$18,000,000, while Los Angeles reported an increase of \$32,000,000, Philadelphia of \$20,000,000 and Boston of \$17,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$12,537,135,000, as compared with \$13,019,911,000 for the preceding week and \$12,749,416,000 for the week ending March 31, 1926.
