STATEMENT FOR THE PRESS

BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending October 19, 1927, aggregated \$15,315,000,000 or 27.9 per cent above the total of \$11,977,000,000 reported for the preceding week, which included but five business days in many of the reporting centers.

Debits for the week under review are \$1,558,000,000 or 11.3 per cent above those for the week ending October 20, 1926. New York City reported an increase of \$1,072,000,000, Chicago \$166,000,000, San Francisco \$73,000,000, Los Angeles \$33,000,000, Minneapolis \$30,000,000 and Philadelphia \$27,000,000, while Boston and Detroit reported reductions of \$22,000,000 and \$25,000,000, respectively.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$14,432,671,000 as compared with \$11,268,500,000 for the preceding week and \$12,920,135,000 for the week ending October 20, 1926.
