BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending November 9, 1927, aggregated \$12,567,000,000 or 18.6 per cent below the total of \$15,434,000,000 reported for the previous week. The current week included but five business days for many of the reporting centers.

Debits for the week under review are \$465,000,000 or 3.8 per cent above those for the week ending November 10, 1926, which also included but five business days for many of the reporting centers. New York City reported an increase of \$456,000,000, Boston \$49,000,000, San Francisco \$38,000,000, Chicago \$35,000,000 and New Orleans \$21,000,000, while Philadelphia, Pittsburgh and Detroit reported reductions of \$65,000,000, \$33,000,000 and \$20,000,000, respectively.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to about \$11,857,000,000 as compared with \$14,656,154,000 for the preceding week and \$11,345,195,000 for the week ending November 10, 1926.
