BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending November 23, 1927, aggregated \$14,697,000,000, or 4.9 per cent below the total of \$15,458,000,000 reported for the preceding week, which included but five business days for many of the reporting centers.

Debits for the week under review are \$2,678,000,000 or 22.3 per cent above those for the week ending November 24, 1926. New York City reported an increase of \$1,953,000,000, Chicago \$136,000,000, Philadelphia \$111,000,000, San Francisco \$92,000,000, Boston \$82,000,000, Cleveland \$20,000,000 and Newark and Los Angeles \$19,000,000 each. The largest reduction, \$35,000,000, was reported by Detroit.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$13,903,699,000 as compared with \$14,657,721,000 for the preceding week and \$11,279,270,000 for the week ending November 24, 1926.
