BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending December 5, which included but five business days, aggregated \$18,700,011,000 or 2.1 per cent below the total of \$19,107,095,000 reported for the preceding week and 19.2 per cent above the total for the week ending December 7, 1927.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$17,779,353,000, as compared with \$18,247,007,000 for the preceding week and \$14,798,903,000 for the week ending December 7, 1927.
