## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending July 17, aggregated \$18,963,000,000 or 22 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week, which included but five business days, and 25 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to approximately \$18,048,000,000, as compared with \$14,703,000,000 for the preceding week and \$14,378,000,000 for the week ending July 18 of last year.
