## BANK DEBITS

Federal Reserve Board  
February 25, 1933.

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in 252 leading cities, aggregated \$5,283,000,000 during the week ended February 22 or 7 per cent above the total for the preceding week and 7 per cent below the total for the corresponding week of last year. The week ended February 22 of this year, as well as the corresponding week of last year, included only five business days in all reporting centers, and the week ended February 15 of this year included only five business days in most of the reporting cities.

Aggregate debits for 135 centers for which figures are available since January 1919 amounted to \$4,920,000,000, compared with \$4,578,000,000 for the preceding week and \$5,267,000,000 for the week ended February 24 of last year. Debits for the six cities in Michigan, for which figures have been published since January 1919, but for which complete reports are not available for the last two weeks, amounted to \$108,000,000 during the week ended February 8, 1933 and to \$154,000,000 during the week ended February 24, 1932.
