BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in 250 leading cities, aggregated \$3,164,000,000 during the week ended March 1 or 56 per cent above the total for the preceding week and somewhat above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for 134 centers for which figures are available since January 1919 amounted to \$7,643,000,000, compared with \$4,868,000,000 for the preceding week and \$7,525,000,000 for the week ended March 2 of last year.
