## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending May 17, aggregated \$6,278,000,000, or 6 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week and 2 per cent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 centers for which a separate total has been maintained since 1919 amounted to \$5,856,000,000, as compared with \$5,526,000,000 for the preceding week and \$5,914,000,000 for the week ending May 18 of last year.
