BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended August 23, aggregated \$5,876,000,000, or 14 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week and 7 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$5,493,000,000, compared with \$6,391,000,000 the preceding week and \$5,105,000,000 the week ended August 24 of last year.
