BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended December 13, aggregated \$5,983,000,000, or 6 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week, which included but five business days, and 7 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$5,545,000,000, compared with \$5,182,000,000 the preceding week and \$5,195,000,000 the week ended December 14 of last year.
