BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended March 7, aggregated \$7,116,000,000, or 14 per cent above the total reported for the last week, which included only five business days.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to about \$6,636,000,000, compared with \$5,836,000,000 last week.
