BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended March 21, aggregated \$7,457,000,000, or 7 per cent above the total reported for last week.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to about \$6,989,000,000, compared with \$6,553,000,000 last week.
