BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended October 31, aggregated \$6,697,000,000, or 6 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week and 5 per cent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to about \$6,239,000,000, compared with \$5,815,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,571,000,000 the week ended November 1 of last year.
