BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended November 14, aggregated \$5,921,000,000, or 2 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week and 8 per cent below the total for the corresponding week of last year. Each of the three weeks included only five business days in most of the reporting cities.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$5,455,000,000, compared with \$5,574,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,002,000,000 the week ended November 15 of last year.
