

STATEMENT FOR THE PRESS

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BANK DEBITS

Federal Reserve Board
December 29, 1934.

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended December 26, which included only five business days, aggregated \$5,915,000,000, or 32 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week and 12 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year, which also included only five business days.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to about \$5,472,000,000, compared with \$8,117,000,000 the preceding week and \$4,905,000,000 the week ended December 27 of last year.
