BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended January 30, aggregated \$7,071,000,000, or 2 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week and 1 per cent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to about \$6,644,000,000, compared with \$6,483,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,715,000,000 the week ended January 31 of last year.
