BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended March 27, aggregated \$7,078,000,000, or 14 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week and 9 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,607,000,000, compared with \$7,630,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,040,000,000 the week ended March 28 of last year.
