BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended May 22, aggregated \$7,247,000,000, or 1 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week and 12 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,711,000,000, compared with \$6,614,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,008,000,000 the week ended May 23, of last year.
