BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended June 26, aggregated \$7,175,000,000, or 17 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week and 8 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,657,000,000, compared with \$8,090,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,167,000,000 the week ended June 27 of last year.
