## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended September 11, aggregated \$6,810,000,000, or slightly above the total reported for the preceding week, which included only five business days, and 13 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,260,000,000, compared with \$6,318,000,000 the preceding week and \$5,565,000,000 the week ended September 12 of last year.
