

STATEMENT FOR THE PRESS

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BANK DEBITS

Board of Governors
of the Federal Reserve System
December 7, 1935

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended December 4, which included only five business days, aggregated \$8,649,000,000, or 1 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week and 26 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year, which also included only five business days.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$8,044,000,000, compared with \$8,003,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,368,000,000 the week ended December 5 of last year.
