BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended January 29, aggregated \$7,683,000,000, or 11 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 9 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,171,000,000, compared with \$8,049,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,621,000,000 the week ended January 30 of last year.
