BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended February 5, aggregated \$9,197,000,000, or 20 percent above the total reported for the preceding week and 30 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to about \$8,597,000,000, compared with \$7,171,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,562,000,000 the week ended February 6 of last year.
