BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended April 1, aggregated \$10,557,000,000, or 37 percent above the total reported for the preceding week and 22 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$9,938,000,000, compared with \$7,192,000,000 the preceding week and \$8,048,000,000 the week ended April 3 of last year.
