BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended April 8, aggregated \$8,404,000,000, or 20 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 21 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,793,000,000, compared with \$9,938,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,446,000,000 the week ended April 10 of last year.
