BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended May 13, aggregated \$7,895,000,000, or 24 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 11 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,319,000,000, compared with \$9,771,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,591,000,000 the week ended May 15 of last year.
