BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended May 27, aggregated \$7,409,000,000, or 8 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 7 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,855,000,000, compared with \$7,461,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,420,000,000 the week ended May 29 of last year.
