BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended July 22, 1936, aggregated \$8,732,000,000, or 4 percent above the total reported for the preceding week and 17 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$8,095,000,000, compared with \$7,686,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,956,000,000 the week ended July 24 of last year.
