BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended August 5, aggregated \$8,513,000,000, or 13 percent above the total reported for the preceding week and 8 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,870,000,000, compared with \$6,945,000,000 the preceding week and \$7,309,000,000 the week ended August 7 of last year.
