

BANK DEBITS TO DEMAND DEPOSIT ACCOUNTS

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts, except interbank and Government accounts, as reported by banks in 345 leading centers for the month of November aggregated \$157 billion. During the past three months debits amounted to \$459 billion or 4.7 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was an increase of 9.3 per cent compared with the corresponding three-months period a year ago; at 6 other centers the increase was .2 per cent; and at 338 other centers it was 3.1 per cent.

Preliminary estimates of the annual rates of turnover of demand deposits in November are 42.2 at New York City, 26.2 at 6 other centers, and 20.7 at 338 other centers.
