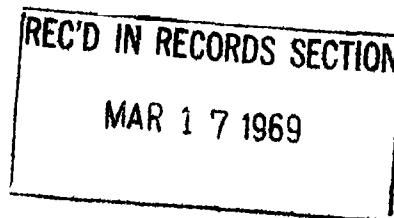

FROM: Mr. Holland

Chairman Martin and several other members of the Federal Open Market Committee have been invited to attend the American Bankers Association's 1969 Monetary Conference, to be held in Copenhagen June 15-20, 1969. To avoid a conflict in meeting dates, it has been suggested that the Committee meeting listed on the tentative schedule for June 17, 1969, be rescheduled for June 24. The latter date is "open" in the sense that there are no conflicts with holidays, etc. Since the preceding and following meetings are scheduled for May 27 and July 15, the only effect on inter-meeting intervals would be to shift a three-week interval from before to after the June meeting.

It is contemplated that this possible change in the tentative schedule will be discussed at the meeting of the Committee to be held on April 1, 1969.
