Mr. Daniel Bell added several others. These include Mr. Garrard Winston who was under-secretary of the Treasury following Parker Gilbert. He is now a member of the New York law firm of Sherman and Sterling. Mr. Richard Wigglesworth is now in Congress. Mr. Elliott Wadsworth is retired and living in Washington. Mr. Floyd Blair of New York worked on the debt settlements as attorney. Senator James Reed of Missouri was head of the judiciary committee which investigated the handling of World War I debt. Mr. William Heffelfinger, now assistant to the fiscal assistant to the Fiscal Assistant Secretary of the Treasury is a very knowledgeable person in all these matters. Mr. James Douglas, now under-secretary for air, (check this title) was fiscal assistant's secretary of the Treasury. Mr. Arthur Ballantine was under-secretary. All these names came up in a discussion of what went on in the 1920's. They should be added to our list.
