Interview with Mr. Floyd Harrison

March 2, 1954

Mr. Harrison is Mr. Eugene Meyers' confidential
man, and Mr. Meyers suggested that we see him in regard to Mr.
Meyers papers. Mr. Harrison doubts every much if the diadries
about which Miss Youngman spoke would contain any material
concerning the Federal Reserve Bank. He thinks they belong to
an earlier period. He himself was with Mr. Meyer both in the
bank and in the War Loan Corporation. He started by saying
that men's memories were very little account, and then he
went on remembering one thing after another, with very vivid
interest. Finally at the end he promised that he would look
up Mr. Meyer's list of papers and send us a record of any—
thing which concerned the Federal Reserve. He confirmed
the fact that Mr. Hyman is writing Mr. Meyer's life.
