Internal Memorandum

With Mr. A. L. Jennings, Assistant Comptroller of the Currency of the Treasury Building.

Mr. Gidney was out of town. Mr. Jennings is an experienced bureaucrat whom I consulted concerning files. He was not at all sure that the Comptroller's office still has files of the period when the Comptroller of the Currency sat with the Board. He thinks they may have gone to Archives. He will find out and let us know. If they have been put in the National Archives, he will get them back and let us see them.

Later. Mr. Jennings telephoned that he could find no trace of these old files, which means old before 1933 or 1935.

He says that Mr. J. W. Pole is, to the best of his beliefs, still alive and living in Florida. He will find out Mr. Pole's address and let us know.
