Section 13 (paragraphs 3, 4, and 5) of Federal Reserve Act was amended so as to authorize the Federal Reserve Board, in its discretion, to increase the amount of acceptances based on the importation or exportation of goods which a member bank of the System might make and which a Federal Reserve bank might discount. (38 Stat. 958, Ch. 93.)

2.100. Abolishment of Federal Reserve districts or banks.— Under the Federal Reserve Act, the Board is not expressly and affirmatively given the power to abolish the Federal Reserve districts or Federal Reserve banks; it may only "readjust" such districts. 30 Op. Atty. Gen. 497 (1915). 1915 BULLETIN 396. 16.102. Use of penalty envelopes in shipping.—The language of this section imposes upon the Federal Reserve banks all expenses involved in the procurement, issuance, and retirement of Federal Reserve notes. Since the shipment of these notes to the subtreasury and ultimately to the bank applying for them, is necessarily a step precedent to their issuance, such expense is one incidental to the issuance of the notes and must be borne by the banks. Accordingly, Federal Reserve notes cannot be sent through the mails under penalty envelopes or labels carrying the frank of the Board. 30 Op. Atty. Gen. 456 (1915). 1915 BULLETIN 355.

11.608. New Hampshire.—A New Hampshire statute provides that no trust company, loan and trust company, loan and banking company, bank or banking company or similar corporation should be appointed administrator of an estate. The Supreme Court of New Hampshire held that this statute was sufficiently broad to apply to national banks as well as to State banks and that therefore a probate court in New Hampshire could not legally appoint a national bank as administrator notwithstanding the provisions of section 11(k) of the Federal Reserve Act authorizing the Federal Reserve Board to grant national banks the right to act as trustee, executor, administrator, or registrar of stocks and bonds when not in contravention of State or local law.
