DESCRIPTION OF LIBRARY -

This is a financial library that serves the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis and the banks of the 9th district: covering Minnesota, Montana, North Dakota, South Dakota and parts of Michigan and Wisconsin.

Our subject collection covers banking, economics (agricultural and international), money, finance, Federal Reserve System, Business conditions and statistics, central banking, foreign banks and special releases from the Departments of labor and commerce.

Fifty percent of the Library's activities are centered around the Research Department and the rest are divided between the member banks and the public. The librarian is directly responsible to the Director of Research. It operates on a flexible budget which is gone over each month by the department head and the Librarian.

The library is open from 8 to 4:15 Monday through Friday.
