Statement that House was the "unseen guardian" of the Federal Reserve bill so infuriated Carter Glass that he wrote AN ADVENTURE IN CONSTRUCTIVE FINANCE (Garden City, N.Y., 1927, to prove that House and Samuel Untermyer, counsel for the Pujo Committee, had nothing to do with the measure. Untermyer retored with his book, WHO IS ENTITLED TO THE CREDIT FOR THE FEDERAL RESERVE ACT? AN ANSWER TO SENATOR CARTER GLASS (New York, 1927). Glass's rejoinder, "Vapor vs. the Record,"

a manuscript in the Carter Glass Papers (University of Va.) was never published.
